DISCUSSION:

The purpose of this Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) is to authorize the appropriation and use of a donation in the amount of \$38,500.00 the Library will receive from The Fort Worth Public Library Foundation to fund a variety of programs presented or offered during the first quarter of calendar year 2025.
