


Summer Creek Drive Public Art Project

Site: Summer Creek Drive, from Altamesa Boulevard to McPherson Boulevard (76123)




Narrative Description

Jill Bedgood's prairie-themed mile markers designed for Summer Creek Drive will complement the artist's public artwork at nearby Chisholm Trail Park, Art + Knowledge, which honors the ancestry of the land and celebrates natural prairie ecosystems: geology, hydrology, and flora and fauna. Using some of the highly detailed, full-color original drawings created by the artist for Chisholm Trail Park, each of the thirteen (13) mile markers will highlight one natural element from the surrounding environment.

Porcelain enamel over steel, 5 inches in diameter



Design Concept for Mile Markers

Porcelain enamel disc with image: 5 inch diameter

Limestone block: 13 inches in length by 9 inches in width by 5 inches in height

Distance numbers: Recessed, 2 inches in height

Each marker will be placed on the interior (pedestrian) edge of the sidewalk

3-mile distance from McPherson Boulevard to Altamesa Boulevard
