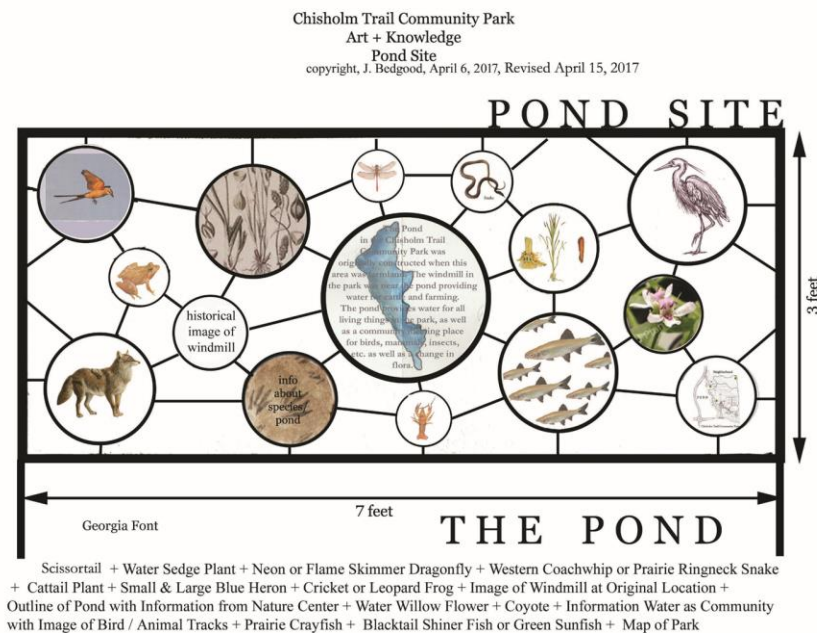
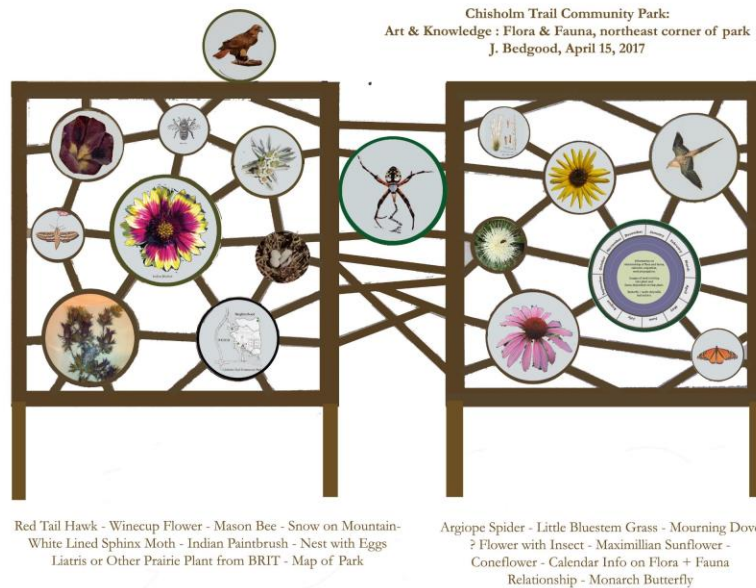
Exhibit A: Artwork Design

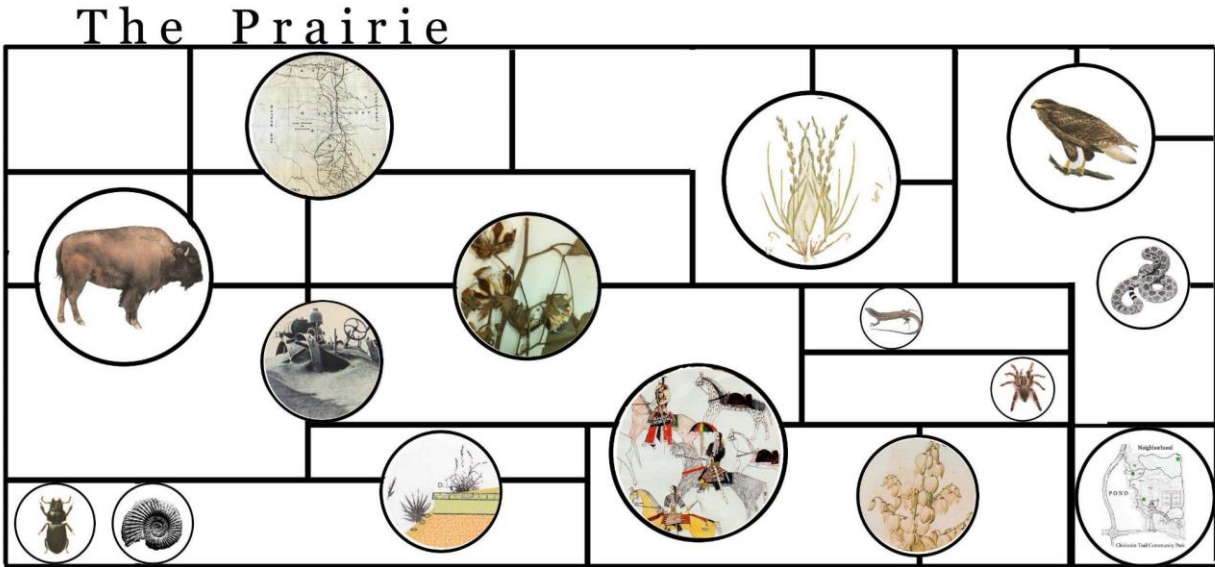

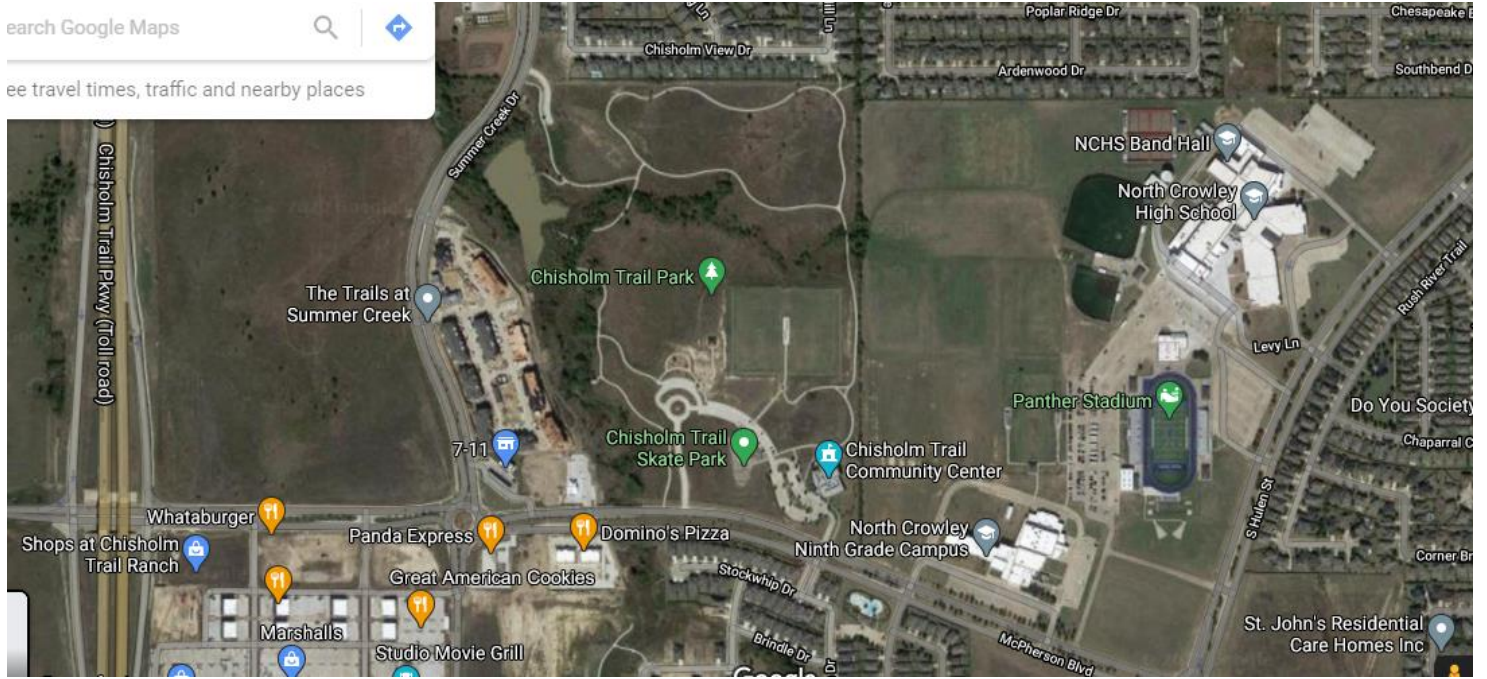
