# **SUBJECT**

(CD 4) Authorize Execution of Amendment No. 1 in the Amount of \$385,460.00, to an Engineering Agreement with BGE, Inc., for Big Fossil Creek Collector Parallel, Phase IV A Project and Adopt Appropriation Ordinance to Effect a Portion of Water's Contribution to the Fiscal Years 2024-2028 Capital Improvement Program

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Authorize execution of Amendment No. 1 in the amount of \$385,460.00, to City Secretary Contract No. 57178, an engineering agreement with BGE, Inc., for the Big Fossil Creek Collector Parallel, Phase IV A project for a revised contract amount of \$1,980,740.00; and
- 2. Adopt the attached appropriation ordinance increasing estimated receipts and appropriations in the Water and Sewer Capital Projects Fund in the amount of \$385,460.00, transferred from available PayGo funds within the Water and Sewer Fund, for the purpose of funding the Big Fossil Creek Collector Parallel, Phase IV A from project (City Project No. 103289) and to effect a portion of Water's contribution to the Fiscal Years 2024-2028 Capital Improvement Program.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

On February 8, 2022, Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) 22-0096, the City Council authorized an engineering agreement in the amount of \$1,595,280.00 with BGE, Inc., (City Secretary Contract No. 57178) for the Big Fossil Creek Collector Parallel, Phase IV A project.

Amendment No. 1 will provide for additional survey and design for the replacement of the existing siphon structure on the 54- inch sewer interceptor under Big Fossil Creek near Broadway Avenue upstream and downstream junction structures, streambank stabilization, additional boundary surveys, design for an 8-inch sanitary sewer main extension on Austin Road to provide and maintain sewer service to existing and future customers and environment assessment.

It is the practice of the Water Department to appropriate its CIP plan throughout the Fiscal Year, instead of within the annual budget ordinance, as projects commence, additional funding needs are identified, and to comply with bond covenants. The actions in the M&C will appropriate funds in support of the Water's portion of the City of Fort Worth's Fiscal Years 2024-2028 Capital Improvement Program, as follows:
