

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND EXTINGUISHING A PORTION A OF W. TERRELL AVENUE, A VARIABLE WIDTH PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY BETWEEN 8TH AVENUE AND 6TH AVENUE, SITUATED IN THE W. WELCH SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 1644, CITY OF FORT WORTH, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT OF GRANDVIEW ADDITION, AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF FORT WORTH ACCORDING TO THE PLAT RECORDED IN VOLUME 63, PAGE 29, PLAT RECORDS, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 64,865 SQUARE FEET OR 1.489 ACRES OF LAND MORE OR LESS; PROVIDING THAT THE CITY SHALL RETAIN ALL EXISTING UTILITY EASEMENTS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That a portion of W. Terrell Avenue, a variable width public right of way between 8th Avenue and 6th avenue, situated in the W. Welch Survey, Abstract No. 1644, City of Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas, according to the plat of Grandview Addition, an addition to the City of Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas filed for record in Volume 63, Page 29, Plat Records, Tarrant County, Texas, and containing, 64,865 square feet or 1.489 acres of land, as more specifically described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, be and the same is vacated and extinguished.

SECTION 2.

That the easements to the land in the above-described vacated right of way is hereby released and shall revert to the adjacent owner as provided by law.

SECTION 3.

All existing utility easements shall be retained by the City until such time all utilities located in the easements are relocated at the owner's expense.

SECTION 4.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5.

That this ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
