- September 11, 2020 - HUD issued award notification
- CDBG-CV3 (second allocation of CDBG-CV funding)
- \$5,468,206 (third round allocation; second round to States)
- \$9,828,497 (Cumulative Allocation of CDBG under CARES Act)
