(ALL) Adopt Appropriation Ordinance Increasing Estimated Receipts and Appropriations in the Library Special Revenue Fund in the Amount of \$50,301.38 for Funds Received from the Fort Worth Public Library Foundation and the Virginia O'Donnell Trust for the Purpose of Supporting Library Services

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached appropriation ordinance increasing estimated receipts and appropriations in the Library Special Revenue Fund in the amount of \$50,301.38 for funds received from The Fort Worth Public Library Foundation and the Viriginia O'Donnell Trust for the purpose of supporting library services.

DISCUSSION:

The purpose of this Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) is to authorize the appropriation and use of two donations the Library received, one in the amount of \$38,500.00 from The Fort Worth Public Library Foundation (Foundation) and the second in the amount of \$11,801.38 from the Virginia O'Donnell Trust.

The Board of Directors of The Fort Worth Library Foundation approved funding in the amount of \$154,000.00 for calendar year 2025, paid quarterly. The purpose of the donation is to fund a variety of programs presented in the second quarter of 2025 that fulfill the following focus areas of the Library's Strategic Service Plan:

- Arts & Culture
- Community Vitality
- Education & Growth
- Books & Reading

As one of the beneficiaries of the Virginia O'Donnell Trust, the Library receives unrestricted distributions to support library services.
