APPROVING THE CREATION OF THE CAVILE PLACE/HISTORIC STOP SIX CHOICE NEIGHBORHOOD FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND ADOPTING A POLICY FOR THE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, in October 2019, the City Council authorized the City to act as a coapplicant with Fort Worth Housing Solutions (FWHS) for a Choice Neighborhood Implementation (CNI) grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and adopted a revised Cavile Place/Historic Stop Six Neighborhood Transformation Plan; and

WHEREAS, a key component of the CNI grant was to develop a Critical Community Improvements (CCI) plan that focuses on activities designed to support and enhance housing and neighborhood initiatives and promote economic development; and

WHEREAS, the Cavile Place/Historic Stop Six Choice Neighborhood Façade Improvement Program (Stop Six FIP) has a committed \$75,000.00 from FWHS in CNI grant funds and the City of Fort Worth, Economic Development Department has committed \$300,000.00 from the Economic Incentives Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to bring a significant benefit and positive impact to the Cavile Place/Historic Stop Six neighborhood;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS THAT:

- 1. The City Council hereby approves the creation of the Stop Six FIP; and
- 2. The City Council hereby adopts the attached Policy for the Stop Six FIP; and
- 3. This resolution shall be effective from and after its passage by the City Council.
