**AUTHORIZE APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE, IF AWARDED, OF FISCAL YEAR 2025  
GRANT FROM THE STATE OF TEXAS, OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT  
GRANT PROGRAM, FIRST RESPONDER MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM AND MAKE ASSURANCES  
REQUIRED BY THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR**

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Governor funds First Responder grant projects throughout the state; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Fort Worth finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Fort Worth to utilize grant funds from the Office of the Governor for the Fort Worth Fire Department in accordance with the permitted uses of the funds under the respective grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Governor grant requirements include authorization of application by the governing body of the applicant and passage of a Resolution by the City Council containing certain assurances; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council designates the City Manager, through any Assistant City Manager, to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant listed on behalf of the City;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, THAT:**

1. The City Council authorizes applications for, and acceptance, if awarded, of the following Fiscal Year 2025 grant from the Office of the Governor, Victims of Crime Act Grant Program, First Responder Mental Health Program;
2. If matching funds are required, the City assures that all matching funds will be provided; and
3. In the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor grant funds, the City assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.
