RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that City Council amend Mayor & Council Communication (M&C) 22-0868 relating to an Economic Development Program Agreement with Vickery Village Development, LLC, or an Affiliate, to waive the affordable housing requirement set forth in Section 15.2 of the Economic Development Program Policy (Resolution No. 5338-01-2021)

DISCUSSION:

On October 25, 2022, City Council approved Mayor and Council (M&C) Communication 22-0860, authorizing the direct sale of City-owned property located at 700 West Vickery Boulevard, Fort Worth, Texas for a total cost of \$225,000.00 to Vickery Village Development, LLC, or an affiliate (Developer), and execution of an Economic Development Program Agreement with the Developer in an amount not to exceed \$225,000.00 to facilitate the development of a mixed-use property located on, or adjacent to, 700 and 800 West Vickery Boulevard (EDPA).

The original M&C approved the EDPA pursuant to the Economic Development Program Policy then in effect (Resolution No. 5338-01-2021) (Policy), which required the Developer to meet certain affordable housing commitments for this type of project under Section 15.2. City staff is requesting a waiver to Section 15.2 of the Policy so that the Developer may proceed with the project as originally intended.

This project is located in COUNCIL DISTRICT 9.
