SUBJECT

(CD 2, CD 3, CD 6, CD 7, CD 8, CD 9 and CD 11) Authorize Execution of a Contract with MW Panel Tech, LLC in the Amount of \$444,217.00 for the 2023 Bridge Rehab Contract 2 at Various Bridge Locations

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council authorize execution of a contract with MW Panel Tech, LLC in the amount of \$444,217.00 for the 2023 Bridge Rehab Contract 2 project at various bridge locations (City Project No. 104177).

DISCUSSION:

In the Fiscal Year 2023 Pay-Go Contract Street Maintenance Program, bridge maintenance projects are grouped into specific contract packages. The recommended construction contract outlined in this Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) will provide rehabilitation for the 9 bridge locations listed below, under the 2023 Bridge Rehab Contract 2 project (City Project No. 104177).

This project was advertised for bid on October 26, 2023, and November 2, 2023, in the *Fort Worth Star-Telegram*. On November 16, 2023, the following bids were received:

In addition to the contract amount, \$267,211.00 is required for project management, material testing and inspection, and \$50,000.00 is provided for project contingencies. Funding is budgeted in the Transportation and Public Works Department's General Capital Projects Fund for the purpose of funding the 2023 Bridge Rehab Contract 2 project.

Construction for this project is expected to start in Spring of 2024 and to be completed by Winter 2024. Upon completion of the project, there will be no anticipated impact on the General Fund operating budget.

M/WBE OFFICE– MW Panel Tech, LLC is in compliance with the City's Business Equity Ordinance by committing to 23% MWBE participation on this project. The City's MWBE goal on this project is 11%.

This project is located in COUNCIL DISTRICTS 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 11.

FISCAL INFORMATION / CERTIFICATION:

The Director of Finance certifies that funds are available in the current capital budget, as previously appropriated, in the General Capital

Projects Fund for 2023 Bridge Rehab Contract 2 project to support the above recommendation and execution of the contract. Prior to any expenditure being incurred, the Transportation and Public Works Department has the responsibility to validate the availability of funds.
