A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,405,510.00, OF WHICH FEDERAL PARTICIPATION IS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,000,000.00, STATE PARTICIPATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,510.00, AND CITY OF FORT WORTH PARTICIPATION IN THE AMOUNT OF 400,000 PROVIDED BY TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT CREDITS, FOR THE LTJG BARNETT BRIDGE PROJECT

WHEREAS, federal law establishes federally funded programs for transportation improvements to implement its public purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Texas Transportation Code, Section 201.103 establishes that the State shall design, construct and operate a system of highways in cooperation with local governments, and Section 222.052 authorizes the Texas Transportation Commission to accept contributions from political subdivisions for development and construction of public roads and the state highway system within the political subdivision, and

WHEREAS, federal and state laws require local governments to meet certain contract standards relating to the management and administration of State and federal funds, and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Transportation Commission has codified 43 TAC, Rules 15.50-15.56 that describe federal, state, and local responsibilities for cost participation in highway improvement and other transportation projects, and

WHEREAS, the Texas Transportation Commission passed Minute Order Number 116522 authorizing the State to undertake and complete a highway improvement or other transportation project generally described as construction of second bridge at the east entrance to NASJRB.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, THAT:

The City Manager, or their designee, is hereby authorized to execute an Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation (CSJ# 0902-90-335) in the approximate amount of \$2,405,510.00, with Federal Participation in the amount of \$2,000,000.00, State Participation in the amount of \$5,510.00, and Local Participation in the amount of 400,000 provided by Transportation Development Credits, for the LTJG Barnett Bridge project.
