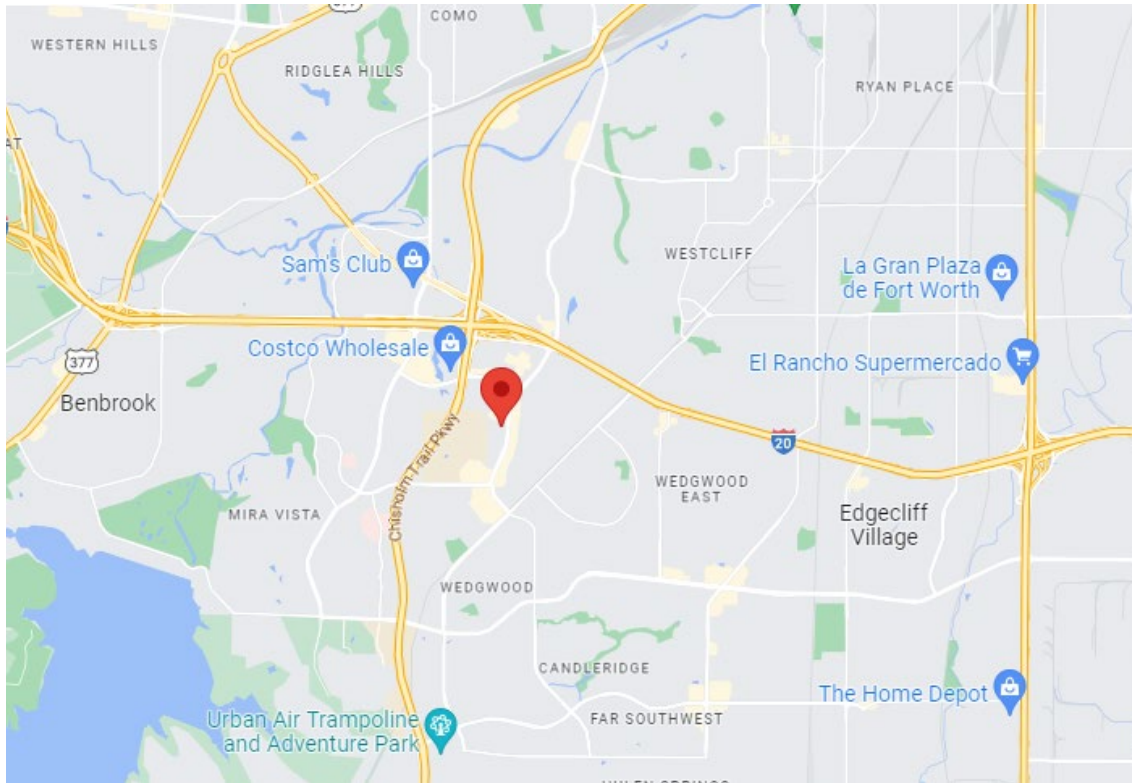


Fire Station 26 Public Art Project

Site: New Fire Station #26, to be located at 4915 W. South Drive (76132)
Architecture will be based on the 1-story prototype developed by RPGA Design Group, Inc. and be substantially the same as Fire Stations #43 and #45



Narrative Description

The artwork associated with the new Fire Station 26 will serve as a gateway for the area. Learning the importance of the firefighters' helmet and its reputation as a "badge of honor," Lazarus's design includes three series of helmets, each uniquely patterned, to represent the various personnel on each shift (A, B, and C) at the station. The current Final Design includes 24 helmets utilizing a combination of mirrored and brushed stainless steel, lit at night with an ultramarine blue colored light to complement the firefighters' trucks.

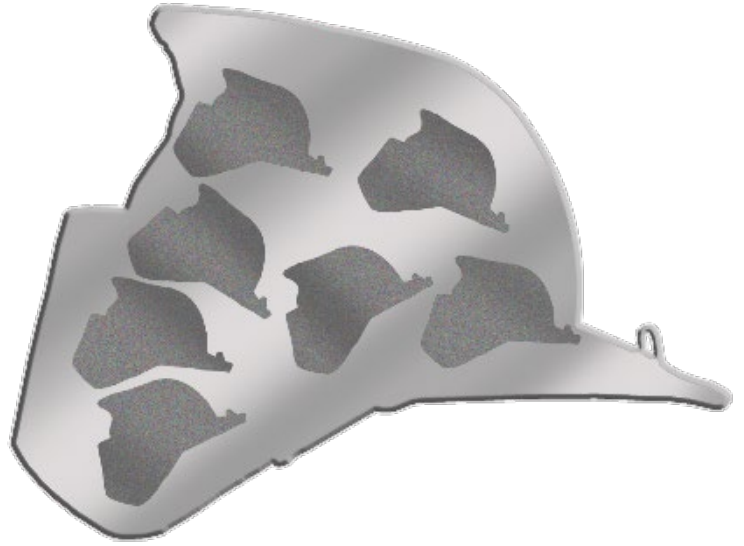


Fire Station 26 Rendering with 2-Story Architecture (Northwest View)
(Left, Facing Wheaton Drive) Helmet Design 1, (Right, Facing Hulen Street) Helmet Design 2

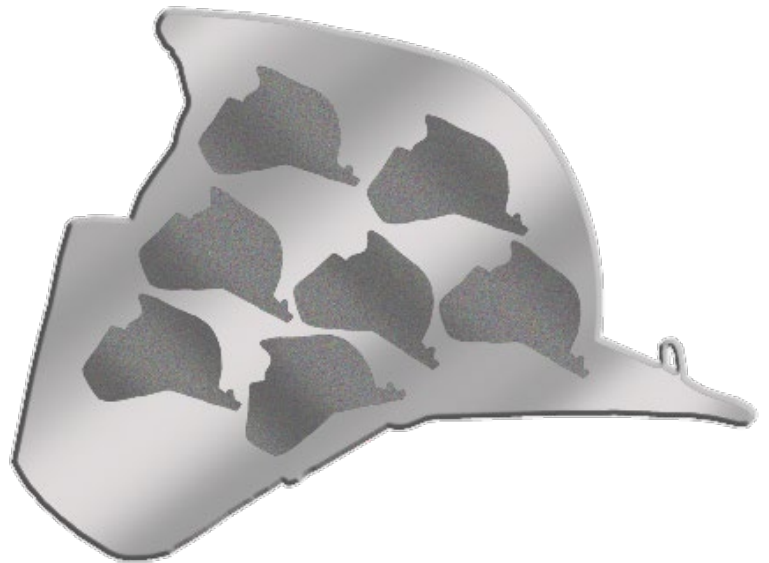


Fire Station 26 Rendering with 2-Story Architecture (Southwest View)
(Left, Facing Hulen Street) Helmet Design 2, (Right, Facing Granbury Road) Helmet Design 3

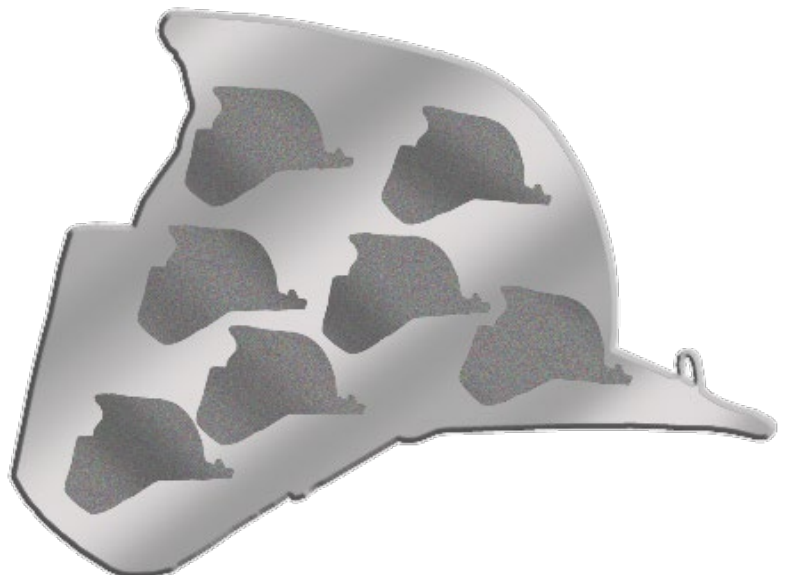

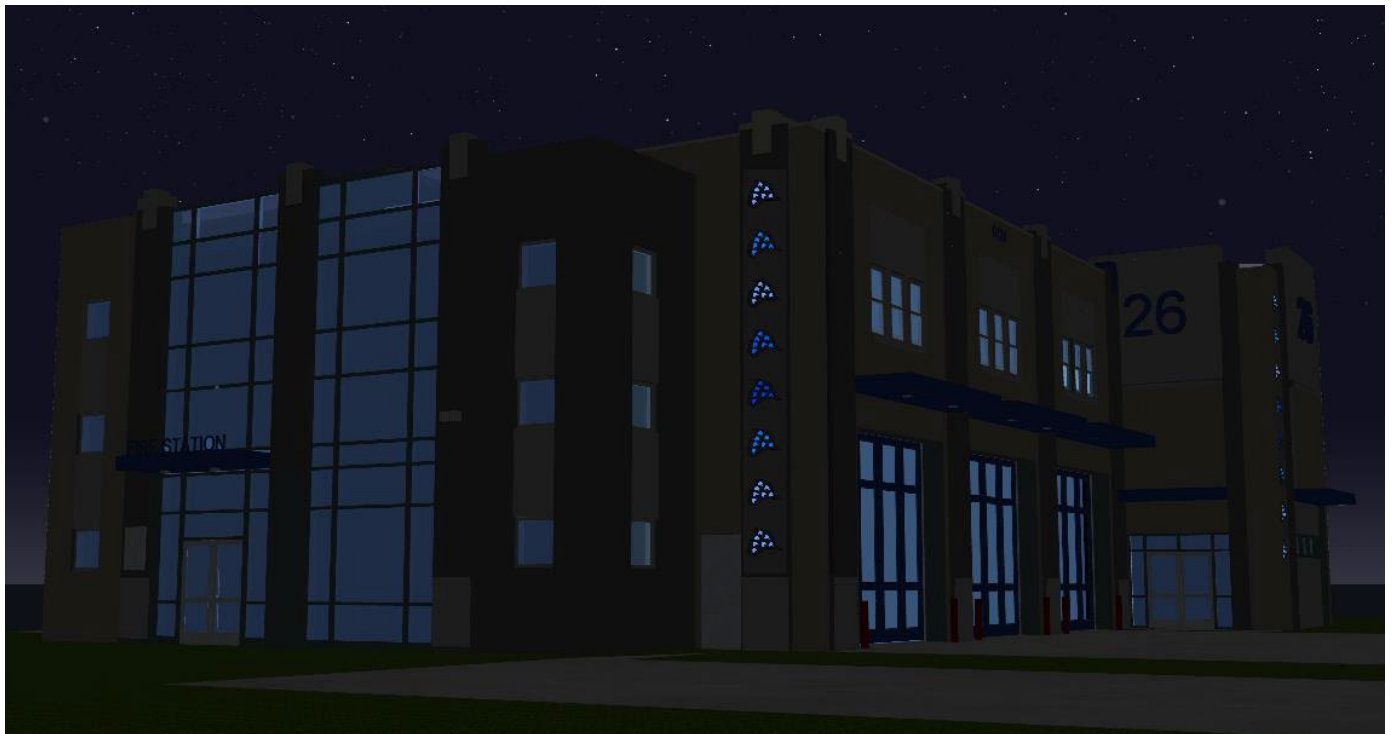


Helmet Mock Up
