AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND EXTINGUISHING A REMNANT OF A VARIABLE WIDTH ALLEY, LOCATED WITHIN THE WILLIAM BUSSELL SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 151, AND BEING A PORTION OF BLOCK 10, K.M. VAN ZANDT'S 2ND ADDITION, FORT WORTH, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS ACCORDING TO THE PLAT RECORDS RECORDED IN INSTRUMENT NO. D219019593 AND VOLUME 106, PAGE 118, RESPECTIVELY, OF THE DEED RECORDS OF TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 5,525 SQUARE FEET OF LAND MORE OR LESS; PROVIDING FOR REVERSION OF FEE IN SAID LAND; PROVIDING THAT THE CITY SHALL RETAIN ALL EXISTING UTILITIES EASEMENTS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That a remnant of a variable width alley, located within the William Bussell Survey, Abstract No. 151, and being a portion of Block 10, Van Zandt's 2nd Addition, an addition to the City of Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas, as shown in the plats thereof recorded in instrument no. D219019593 and Volume 106, Page 117, respectively, of the Deed Records of Tarrant County, Texas, containing approximately 5,525 square feet of land more or less, and as more specifically described in Exhibits A and B attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference be and the same is vacated and extinguished.

SECTION 2.

That the easement to the land in the above-described vacated alley right-of-way is hereby released and shall revert to the adjacent owner as provided by law.

SECTION 3.

All existing utility easements shall be retained by the City until such time all utilities located in that easement are relocated at the owner's expense.

SECTION 4.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5.

That this ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
