A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AN ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO INCREASE THE TOTAL PROJECT AMOUNT TO \$664,120.00 WITH FEDERAL PARTICIPATION IN THE AMOUNT \$428,701.00, STATE PARTICIPATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$27,319.00, AND LOCAL PATRICIPATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$208,100.00 FOR ENGINEERING, ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES AND CONSTRUCTION OF SOUTH HULEN STREET AT OAKMONT BOULEVARD HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, federal law establishes federally funded programs for transportation improvements to implement its public purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Texas Transportation Code, Section 201.103 establishes that the State shall design, construct and operate a system of highways in cooperation with local governments, and Section 222.052 authorizes the Texas Transportation Commission to accept contributions from political subdivisions for development and construction of public roads and the state highway system within the political subdivision, and

WHEREAS, federal and state laws require local governments to meet certain contract standards relating to the management and administration of State and federal funds, and

WHEREAS, the Texas Transportation Commission has codified 43 TAC, Rules 15.50-15.56 that describe federal, state, and local responsibilities for cost participation in highway improvement and other transportation projects, and

WHEREAS, the Texas Transportation Commission passed Minute Order Numbers 116522 authorizing the State to undertake and complete a highway improvement or other transportation project generally described as rehabilitate traffic signal, improve traffic signals and add left turn lane; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Worth identified the need to improve traffic signals and construct an additional northbound left turn lane at the South Hulen Street at Oakmont Boulevard intersection; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Worth and Texas Department of Transportation entered into an Advance Funding Agreement (City Secretary No. 60426; CSJ 0902-90-212) for the South Hulen Street at Oakmont Boulevard Highway Safety Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the amendment to the Advance Funding Agreement reflects increased federal participation in the amount of \$428,701.00, increased state participation in the amount of \$3,958.00, and reduced City of Fort Worth participation to the amount of \$42,870.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, THAT:

The City Manager or their designee is hereby authorized to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation (City Secretary No. 60426; CSJ: 0902-90-212) in the amount of \$664,120.00, with federal participation in the amount of \$428,701.00, state participation in the amount of \$27,319.00, and local participation in the amount of \$208,100.00 for engineering, environmental services and construction of South Hulen Street at Oakmont Boulevard highway safety improvements project. All cost overruns will be the responsibility of the City of Fort Worth.
