(CD 10) Authorize Execution of a Community Facilities Agreement with GBTM Sendera, LLC, with City Participation in the Amount Not to Exceed \$166,201.22 for Oversizing an 8-inch Water Main to a 16-inch Water Main for Anticipated Future Growth in North Fort Worth

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council authorize the execution of a Community Facilities Agreement with GBTM Sendera, LLC, with City participation in an amount not to exceed \$166,201.22 for oversizing an 8-inch water main to a 16-inch water main for anticipated future growth in north Fort Worth.

DISCUSSION:

GBTM Sendera, LLC, (Developer) is constructing Madero Phase 16 development west of Sendera Ranch Boulevard and north of Rancho Canyon Way. The Water Department is seeking to participate in the project to oversize an 8-inch water main to 16-inch water main. The Madero Phase 16 project is assigned City Project No. 104386 and Accela System Record IPRC22-0220.

In accordance with Chapter 212, Subchapter C of the Texas Local Government Code, the City's participation in the contract is exempt from competitive bidding requirements because the contract is for oversizing public improvements being constructed by the Developer, the Developer will execute a performance bond to cover the total project cost, including all of the City's cost participation, and the City's cost participation will be determined in accordance with the City's community facilities agreement (CFA) unit price ordinance.

The City's cost participation in the construction and oversizing of the water mains is estimated to be in an amount not to exceed \$166,201.22 as shown in the table below. Payments to the Developer are estimated to be \$128,632.57 for construction costs, \$30,910.00 for design services fees and \$2,572.65 for material testing costs. The City's cost participation also includes \$4,086.00 to cover the City's portion of construction inspection service fees, administrative material testing service fees, and water lab testing fees. An additional \$19,294.89 in contingency funds will cover the City's portion of any change orders.
