(CD 2) Adopt Resolution Authorizing Execution of an Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation in the Amount of \$599,860.00, of Which \$299,813.00 is Federal Participation, \$85,047.00 is State Participation, and \$215,000.00 is the City of Fort Worth Participation for the State Highway 183 and Deen Road Intersection Improvements Project (2022 Bond Program)

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing execution of an Advance Funding Agreement with Texas Department of Transportation in the amount of \$599,860.00 with Federal participation in the amount of \$299,813.00, State participation in the amount of \$85,047.00, and Local participation in the amount of \$215,000.00 for the State Highway 183 and Deen Road Intersection Improvements project (City Project No. 104037).

DISCUSSION:

The purpose of this Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) is to adopt a resolution authorizing execution of an On-System Advanced Funding Agreement (AFA) with Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) for the State Highway 183 and Deen Road Intersection Improvements project (City Project No. 104037).

The Texas Transportation Commission passed Minute Order Number 116522 authorizing the State to undertake and complete a highway improvement or other transportation project generally described as intersection improvements at State Highway(SH) 183 and Deen Road. The Intersection Improvements at SH 183 and Deen Road project intends to create a cost-effective solution to improve efficiency while increasing visibility, safety, and traffic flow. The project scope includes rebuilding the traffic signal and adding safety lighting, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) ramps, pavement marking, signage, and a westbound right turn lane. The construction of the project will be the responsibility of TxDOT and the work performed will be within the TxDOT right-of-way.

This project is included in the 2022 Bond Program. The City's Extendable Commercial Paper (ECP) (M&C 22-0607; Ordinance 25675-08-2022) provides liquidity to support the appropriation. Available resources will be used to actually make any interim progress payments until debt is issued. Once debt associated with a project is sold, debt proceeds will reimburse the interim financing source in accordance with the statement expressing official Intent to Reimburse that was adopted as part of the ordinance canvassing the bond election (Ordinance 25515-05-2022).

Funding is budgeted in the TPW Dept Highway & Streets Department's 2022 Bond Program Fund for the purpose of funding the SH 183 & Deen Rd Intersection Improvements project, as appropriated.

The above-mentioned project is located in COUNCIL DISTRICT 4.
