SUBJECT

(ALL) Authorize the Rejection of All Responses for Request for Proposals No. 26-0154 Supplemental Disaster Recovery – Home Repair Services for the Neighborhood Services Department

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council authorize the rejection of all responses for Request for Proposals No. 26-0154 Supplemental Disaster Recovery – Home Repair Services for the Neighborhood Services Department.

DISCUSSION:

On April 8, 2026, the City of Fort Worth (City) issued Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 26-0154 Supplemental Disaster Recovery - Home Repair Services supporting the Homeowners Assistance Repair and Rehabilitation Program (HARRP). Notice of the RFP was advertised in the *Fort Worth Star-Telegram* on April 8, 2026, April 15, 2026, April 22, 2026, and April 29, 2026. The City received two (2) responses: Camelot Roofing and Strixis Construction Group.

Upon review of the proposals, staff determined that both responses were non-responsive to the solicitation requirements. Camelot Roofing failed to provide required pricing information for any of the fourteen (14) service categories identified in the solicitation and therefore did not meet the proposal pricing requirements.

Strixis Construction Group failed to provide multiple required proposal components, including the required number of references, financial and supplier references, business licenses and trade certifications, and required financial documentation. These deficiencies prevented the City from evaluating the proposer’s qualifications, financial capacity, and ability to perform the Scope of Services.

Because both proposals were determined to be non-responsive, staff requests that the City reject all responses. The Purchasing Division will coordinate with the Neighborhood Services Department to determine next steps regarding the solicitation and any potential revisions to the specifications and proposal requirements moving forward.

A Form 1295 is not required because: This M&C does not request approval of a contract with a business entity.
