ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF THE ENTIRETY OF WORTH CREEK PARKWAY BETWEEN BREWER BOULEVARD AND SUMMER CREEK DRIVE TO TARLETON STATE PARKWAY BETWEEN THE SAME STREETS; MAKING THIS ORDINANCE CUMULATIVE OF ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AFFECTING STREET NAMES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That Worth Creek Parkway, located between Brewer Boulevard and Summer Creek Drive, as more specifically depicted in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, be and the same is hereby changed to Tarleton State Parkway.

SECTION 2.

That this ordinance shall be cumulative of all other ordinances affecting the names of streets in the city of Fort Worth except in so far as it may be in conflict with the provisions of those ordinances, in which instance they are expressly repealed.

SECTION 3.

That this ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
