

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND EXTINGUISHING A PORTION OF LOWE STREET, SITUATED IN THE P.M. TRUITT SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 1508, FORT WORTH, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, DEDICATED BY THE PLAT OF SHAW-CLARKE ADDITION, AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT RECORDED IN VOLUME 204, PAGE 54, OF THE PLAT RECORDS OF TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, AND CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 8,051 SQUARE FEET OR 0.185 OF LAND MORE OR LESS; PROVIDING FOR REVERSION OF FEE IN SAID LAND; PROVIDING THAT THE CITY SHALL RETAIN ALL EXISTING UTILITIES EASEMENTS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That a portion of Lowe Street, a sixty (60) foot wide right-of-way, situated in the P.M. Truitt Survey, Abstract No. 1508, Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas, dedicated by the plat of Shaw-Clarke Addition, an addition to the City of Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas, according to the plat recorded in Volume 204, Page 54, of the Plat Records of Tarrant County, Texas and containing 8,051 square feet or 0.185 acre of land more or less, and as more specifically described in Exhibits A and B attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference be and the same is vacated and extinguished.

SECTION 2.

That the easement to the land in the above-described vacated right-of-way is hereby released and shall revert to the adjacent owner as provided by law.

SECTION 3.

All existing utility easements be shall be retained by the City until such time all utilities located in that easement are relocated at the owner's expense.

SECTION 4.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5.

That this ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
