AN ORDINANCE INCREASING ESTIMATED RECEIPTS AND APPROPRIATIONS IN THE FORT WORTH PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 11 – STOCKYARDS FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000.00, FROM AVAILABLE UNRESERVED FUND BALANCE AND APPROVE THE OPERATING CASH FLOW ADVANCE IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000.00 FOR FORT WORTH STOCKYARDS, INC IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 372.023 OF THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE AND SECTION VI.11 (A) I OF THE OPERATING PID POLICY; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; MAKING THIS ORDINANCE CUMULATIVE OF PRIOR ORDINANCES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That the budget of the City of Fort Worth for Fiscal Year 2023-2024, as enacted by Ordinance 26453-09-2023, as amended, is hereby further amended to make the following reallocations to amounts allocated to various City departments for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 in the Budget of the City Manager, there shall also be increasing estimated receipts and appropriations in the Fort Worth Public Improvement District 11 – Stockyards Fund in the amount of \$100,000.00, from available unreserved fund balance and approve the operating cash flow advance in the amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 for Fort Worth Stockyards, Inc in accordance with Chapter 372.023 of the Texas Local Government Code and section vi.11 (a)i of the Operating PID Policy.

SECTION 2.

That should any portion, section or part of a section of this ordinance be declared invalid, inoperative or void for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision, opinion or judgment shall in no way impair the remaining portions, sections, or parts of sections of this ordinance, which said remaining provisions shall be and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3.

That this ordinance shall be cumulative of Ordinance 26453-09-2023 and all other ordinances and appropriations amending the same except in those instances where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with such other ordinances and appropriations, in which instance said conflicting provisions of said prior ordinances and appropriations are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 4.

This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
