(ALL) Authorize Execution of a Unit Price Contract with C. Greenscaping, LP, in an Amount Not to Exceed \$550,000.00 for Task Order Construction Services Related to Brick Pavement Rehabilitation Projects at Various Locations with Two Consecutive One Year Renewals for the Same Amount

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council authorize execution of a unit price contract with C. Greenscaping, LP, in an amount not to exceed \$550,000.00 for task order construction services for brick pavement rehabilitation projects at various locations in the City, with up to two consecutive one year renewals for the same amount.

DISCUSSION:

This contract will provide construction services on an as-needed (task order) basis for brick pavement rehabilitation projects throughout the City. The brick rehabilitation projects include the installation of brick pavement, brick sidewalks, curb ramps, driveways, concrete curb and gutter, and other localized pavement maintenance activities. The contract amount is capped at \$550,000.00. The contract may be renewed up to two (2) consecutive one year renewals for the same amount. The project was bid in a low bid format to determine unit prices to be paid when task orders are issued under the brick pavement rehabilitation unit price projects.

This project was advertised for bid on November 2, 2023, and November 9, 2023, in the *Fort Worth Star-Telegram*. On November 30, 2023, the following bid was received:

This task order contract will serve current and future capital projects as-needed, and a funds availability verification will be performed by the Transportation & Public Works Contract Compliance Managers prior to task order assignment.

M/WBE OFFICE— C. Greenscaping, LP, is in compliance with the City's Business Equity Ordinance by committing to 100% MWBE participation on this project. The City's MBE goal on this project is 15%.

This unit price contract is located in ALL COUNCIL DISTRICTS.
