(ALL) Authorize Settlement of the Claims of Joseph Humphrey in the Amount of \$170,354.39

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Authorize settlement and payment in the amount of \$170,354.39, for full and complete disposition of the referenced claims of Joseph Humphrey; and
- 2. Authorize the appropriate City personnel to execute all documents necessary to complete the settlement.

DISCUSSION:

Mr. Joseph Humphrey filed a claim against the City of Fort Worth arising out of an automobile accident that occurred on August 16, 2020. It is alleged that a Fort Worth Police vehicle disregarded a red light and collided with Mr. Humphrey's vehicle. As a result, Mr. Humphrey was transported to JPS Emergency Room Trauma via Medstar from the scene, suffering from multiple serious injuries to multiple organ systems. He underwent immediate surgery and incurred substantial medical bills due to his injuries. The parties have reached an agreement to settle the claim in the amount of \$170,354.39.
