RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Accept funds in the amount up to \$545,000.00 from the sale of platted Lake Worth lots to Lessees authorized by Mayor and Council Communication L-15964;
- 2. Adopt the attached appropriation ordinance increasing estimated receipts and appropriations in the Water and Sewer Fund in an amount up to \$545,000.00, from available funds, for the purpose of transferring to the Water and Sewer Capital Projects Fund for funding the Lake Worth infrastructure programmable project; and
- 3. Adopt the attached appropriation ordinance increasing estimated receipts and appropriations in the Water and Sewer Capital Projects Fund in an amount up to \$545,000.00 transferred from available funds within the Water and Sewer Fund, for the purpose of funding the Lake Worth infrastructure programmable project (City Project No. P00101).

DISCUSSION:

This Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) is to authorize the use of an amount up to \$545,000.00 from the Water and Sewer Fund transferred to the Water and Sewer Capital Projects Fund for funding the Lake Worth Infrastructure programmable project in and around Lake Worth. The amount of funds being transferred represents Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 revenues from the sale of platted Lake Worth lots to lessees authorized by Council action on M&C L-15964 on November 8, 2016. Revenue is deposited into the Trust Fund, which has since been closed, and the Lake Worth lots were recorded as an asset in the Water and Sewer Fund at the time of Lake Worth's creation.

This project is located in COUNCIL DISTRICT 7.
