SUBJECT

(CD 4, CD 5, CD 8, and CD 9) Authorize Execution of a Contract with Ragle, Inc., in the Amount of \$446,675.84 for 2021 Bridge Rehabilitation at Eight Locations

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council authorize execution of a contract with Ragle, Inc., in the amount of \$446,675.84 for the 2021 Bridge Rehabilitation Contract 2 project (City Project No. 103097) at eight locations.

DISCUSSION:

The purpose of the Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) is to authorize the execution of a contract with Ragle, Inc., in the amount of \$446,675.84 for 2021 Bridge Rehabilitation Contract 2 project at eight locations. The contract provides for the repair and rehabilitation of eight bridges listed below:

Major bridge repair and rehabilitation includes structural repair; concrete and metal rail installation/repair; expansion joint replacement; metal beam guard fence repair, and guardrail end treatment replacement. Construction is expected to start in late summer 2021 and be completed by winter 2021. Upon completion of the project, there will be no anticipated impact on the general fund operating budget. The project was advertised for bid on March 4, 2021 and March 11, 2021 in the *Fort Worth Star-Telegram*. On April 1, 2021, the following bids were received:
