

# A Resolution

**CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 2, 2026, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A CITY COUNCIL MEMBER FOR CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 10 TO SERVE THE REMAINDER OF AN UNEXPIRED TERM**

**WHEREAS**, on January 13, 2026, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 28252-01-2026, calling for and ordering a special election be held on Saturday, May 2, 2026, for the election of a Council Member for District 10 to serve the remainder of an unexpired term until the regular City Council election in May 2027; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 2, 2026, a special election was held at which the qualified voters of District 10 for the City had the opportunity to vote for the purpose of electing a Council Member for District 10; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Texas Election Code, the City Council of the City of Fort Worth is required to canvass the returns and declare the results of the election;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The declarations and findings contained in the preamble of this Resolution are hereby found to be true and correct and shall be made a part hereof.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council hereby finds and declares that the election for a City Council Member in District 10 was held on May 2, 2026, at which election qualified voters were given the opportunity to vote for the purpose of electing a Council Member from District 10.

**SECTION 3.** The City Council further finds and declares that the returns for such election are as follows:
