(ALL) Conduct Public Hearing and Adopt Ordinance Amending the Neighborhood and Community Park Dedication Policy to Authorize the Use of Park Dedication and Development Fees in Adjacent Extraterritorial Jurisdiction, to Revise the Authorized Uses of Interest Earned on Park Dedication and Development Fees Collected, and to Make Non-Substantive Changes

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council conduct a public hearing and adopt the attached ordinance amending the Neighborhood and Community Park Dedication Policy to authorize a revised use of the park dedication and development fees and interest earnings.

DISCUSSION:

The purpose of this Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) is for the City Council to authorize the adoption of amendments to the Neighborhood and Community Park Dedication Policy to authorize a revised use of the park dedication and development fees and interest earnings.

Background

The Neighborhood and Community Park Dedication Policy (Policy) originated in 1977 and is part of the City's Subdivision Ordinance. Since then, the Policy has been revised several times to strategically enhance the City's ability to meet the recreational and open space needs of a growing population without hindering development and re-development initiatives. The purpose of the Policy is to ensure that adequate recreational areas in the form of neighborhood and community-based parks are provided to meet the need created by residential development.

Current Update

This amendment is to allow the use of park dedication and development fees in the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction and to revise the allowed uses of interest earnings.

On January 16, 2025, the Park & Recreation Department presented the proposed amendments to the Development Advisory Committee (DAC). On January 22, 2025, the Park & Recreation Advisory Board endorsed the proposed updates to the Policy. Upon adoption, the amended Neighborhood and Community Park Dedication Policy will be effective on March 1, 2025.
