(CD 8, CD 9, and CD 11) Authorize Rejection of All Bids for the Installation of Dynamic Message Signs on the Rosedale Street Corridor for Intelligent Transportation Systems 8 Project

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council authorize the rejection of all bids received for the installation of dynamic message signs on the Rosedale Street corridor for the Intelligent Transportation Systems 8 project.

DISCUSSION:

This Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) is to reject all bids received for the Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS-8) Rosedale Street corridor Dynamic Message Signs (DMS) project.

The purpose of the ITS-8 project is to implement and activate a corridor management system, real-time traveler information with high-speed communications on the Rosedale Street corridor from Forest Park Boulevard to Miller Road. The project scope includes procuring and installing two (2) dynamic message signs on the Rosedale Street corridor for roadside vehicular messaging. These DMS signs will allow the City to broadcast information based on real-time traffic conditions to improve the traffic flow along the corridor.

This project is funded using Federal Grant funds and is within the Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT) Right-Of-Way, therefore TxDOT has jurisdiction over the bidding process. The City, as a project partner with TxDOT, undertook the bidding process.

This project was advertised for bids on July 18 and July 25, 2024 in the Fort Worth Star-Telegram. On August 15, 2024 one company submitted bids as follows:

Bean Electrical, LLC	\$671,140.00

TxDOT performed an extensive review of the bids and found discrepancies that could not be waived. Therefore, TxDOT advised the City in December 2024, that the bid was non-responsive. The City intends to coordinate with TxDOT to re-advertise the project by the end of July 2025. In order to increase the likelihood that future bids will include all TxDOT required documents, additional information will be included in the bidding documents.

Staff recommends authorizing the rejection of all bids in anticipation of TxDOT's formal concurrence to reject all bids.

The project is located in COUNCIL DISTRICTS 8, 9, and 11.

A Form 1295 is not required because: This M&C does not request approval of a contract with a business entity.
