A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE NECESSITY FOR ACQUIRING REAL PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING ITS APPROPRIATION OR CONDEMNATION FOR PUBLIC USE

WHEREAS, the Fort Worth City Council on September, 2019, in M&C L,
ordered and decreed that a public necessity existed for 1.395 acres in permanent right-of-way easement
and a total of 0.7869 acres for temporary construction easements from improved property located east of
the intersection of Cleburne Road and McPherson Boulevard in the Moses Walters Survey, Abstract No.
1598, Tarrant County, Texas, in the exhibits attached to the above-referenced M&C those exhibits are
incorporated herein for all purposes (the "Property");

WHEREAS, the Fort Worth City Council has determined that:

- the Property is needed for the McCart Avenue/McPherson Boulevard Project (the "Project") that will extend McPherson Boulevard from Cleburne Road eastward to the future McCart Avenue:
- the land rights in the Property are needed for new travel lanes, storm drainage improvements, sidewalks, and streetlights as necessary;
- public necessity required the acquisition by condemnation of the Property, located within the alignment of the Project;
- the use of the Property will be a public use; and
- the Real Property Division of the Property Management Department is authorized to acquire by negotiation the Property needed for the Project.
