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AN ORDINANCE INCREASING APPROPRIATIONS IN THE 2022 BOND PROGRAM FUND IN THE AMOUNT UP TO \$160,190,000.00, SUBJECT TO THE SALE OF GENERAL PURPOSE, SERIES 2024 BONDS, WITH SUCH AMOUNT SUBJECT TO REDUCTION TO CONFORM TO FINAL FIGURES REFLECTED IN BOND CLOSING DOCUMENTS, FOR EXPENDITURES ASSOCIATED WITH 2022 BOND PROJECTS; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; MAKING THIS ORDINANCE CUMULATIVE OF PRIOR ORDINANCES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS:

## SECTION 1.

That in addition to those amounts allocated to the various City departments for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 in the Budget of the City Manager, there shall also be the following changes in the 2022 Bond Program Fund: an increase in appropriations in the amount up to \$160,190,000.00, subject to the sale of general purpose, series 2024 bonds, with such amount subject to reduction to conform to final figures reflected in bond closing documents, for expenditures associated with 2022 bond projects.

## SECTION 2.

That should any portion, section or part of a section of this ordinance be declared invalid, inoperative or void for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision, opinion or judgment shall in no way impair the remaining portions, sections, or parts of sections of this ordinance, which said remaining provisions shall be and remain in full force and effect.

## SECTION 3.

That this ordinance shall be cumulative of Ordinance 26453-09-2023 and all other ordinances and appropriations amending the same except in those instances where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with such other ordinances and appropriations, in which instance said conflicting provisions of said prior ordinances and appropriations are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 4.

This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
