AUTHORIZE APPLICATION FOR AND AUTHORIZE ACCEPTANCE OF THE GRANT PROJECT FOR THE VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT FORMULA GRANT PROGRAM FROM THE STATE OF TEXAS, OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION AND MAKE ASSURANCES REQUIRED BY THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice Division of the Governor's Office (CJD) funds grant projects throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Fort Worth finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Fort Worth to utilize grant funds from the CJD for the Fort Worth Police Department Victim Assistance Unit for an additional Victim Assistance Specialist Position and a High Risk Family Violence Specialist Position during the Fiscal Year 2022 Grant Cycle; and

WHEREAS, release of the grant funds is contingent upon the completion of specified requirements set by the CJD, including the passage of a Resolution by the City Council containing certain assurances.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, THAT:

1. The City Council ratifies the above-referenced grant project from the Victims of Crime Act Formula Grant Program from the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division;
2. The City Council designates the City Manager, through the Assistant City Manager, to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate this grant on behalf of the City; and
3. In the event of loss or misuse of the CJD grant funds, the City assures that the funds will be returned to the CJD in full.
