A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN ADVANCED FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,256,970.00, OF WHICH FEDERAL PARTICIPATION IS \$9,300,000.00, STATE PARTICIPATION IS \$491,970.00, AND LOCAL PARTICIPATION IS \$465,000.00 PLUS TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT CREDITS IN THE AMOUNT OF 1,860,000, PLUS ANY COST OVERRUNS, FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE EVERMAN PARKWAY SAFE STREETS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, federal law establishes federally funded programs for transportation improvements to implement its public purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Transportation Code, Section 201.103 establishes that the State shall design, construct and operate a system of highways in cooperation with local governments, and Section 222.052 authorizes the Texas Transportation Commission to accept contributions from political subdivisions for development and construction of public roads and the state highway system within the political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, federal and state laws require local governments to meet certain contract standards relating to the management and administration of State and federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Transportation Commission has codified 43 TAC, Rules 15.50-15.56 that describe federal, state, and local responsibilities for cost participation in highway improvement and other transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Transportation Commission passed Minute Order Number 116752 authorizing the State to undertake and complete a highway improvement or other transportation project generally described as constructing pedestrian infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the portion of the project work covered by this Agreement is identified in the Agreement, Article 3, Scope of Work (Project); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Worth (“City”), in conjunction with the City of Everman and Tarrant County, desires to improve safety by installing multimodal bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure within the project area, which connects four schools generally along Everman Parkway and South Race Street, within the Cities of Fort Worth and Everman; and

WHEREAS, the Everman Parkway Safe Streets Project will improve safety for pedestrians, bicyclists and motorists as well as enhance the aesthetics of the roadways within the project area by installing cycle tracks, bike lanes, green-stamped sharrows and associated safety infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas

Department of Transportation for the Everman Parkway Safe Streets Project in the amount of \$10,256,970.00 with local cash participation in the amount of \$465,000.00 plus the use of Transportation Development Credits in the amount of 1,860,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, THAT:

The City Council authorizes the City Manager, or their designee, to execute an Advance Funding Agreement and all other necessary documents with the Texas Department of Transportation in the amount of \$10,256,970.00 with federal participation in the amount of \$9,300,000.00, state participation in the amount of \$491,970.00, and local participation in the amount of \$465,000.00 plus transportation development credits in the amount of 1,860,000, and any cost overruns for the Everman Parkway Safe Streets Project.
