(CD 8) Authorize Execution of a Contract with Insituform Technologies, LLC., in the Amount of \$2,695,235.50 for the Sycamore Creek Interceptor Improvement Project, Provide for Project Costs for a Project Total in the Amount of \$3,089,528.00, and Adopt the Attached Appropriation Ordinance to Effect a Portion of Water's Contribution to the Fiscal Years 2022-2026 Capital Improvement Program

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Authorize execution of a contract with Insituform Technologies, LLC., in the amount of \$2,695,235.50 for the Sycamore Creek Interceptor Improvement; and
- Adopt the attached appropriation ordinance increasing estimated receipts and appropriations in the Water and Sewer Capital Projects Fund in the amount of \$3,089,528.00, transferred from available funds in the Water and Sewer Fund, to fund the Sycamore Creek Interceptor Improvement project (City Project No. C02200) to effect a portion of Water's contribution to the Fiscal Years 2022-2026 Capital Improvement Program.

DISCUSSION:

The Sycamore Creek Interceptor Improvement was advertised for bid on December 23, 2021 and December 30, 2021 in the *Fort Worth Star-Telegram*. On January 27, 2022 the following bids were received.

^{*}Staff recommends the approval of the low bid received for Total 2 due to the longer life span and reduced maintenance costs of polymer concrete manholes.

In addition to the contract cost, \$259,530.00 is required for project management, inspection and material testing and \$134,762.50 is provided for project contingency.

It is the practice of the Water Department to appropriate its CIP plan throughout the fiscal year as projects commence, additional funding needs are identified, and to comply with bond covenants. The actions in the M&C will appropriate funds in support of the Water's portion of the City of Fort Worth's Fiscal Years 2022-2026 Capital Improvement Program, as follows:
