AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND EXTINGUISHING A PORTION OF A 16 FOOT WIDE ALLEY, LOCATED IN BLOCK 10, POLYTECHNIC HEIGHTS ADDITION, AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS ACCORDING TO THE PLAT RECORDED IN VOLUME 63, PAGE 109 OF THE DEED RECORDS OF TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 1,600 SQUARE FEET OF LAND; PROVIDING FOR REVERSION OF FEE IN SAID LAND; PROVIDING THAT THE CITY SHALL RETAIN ALL EXISTING UTILITIES EASEMENTS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That a portion of a sixteen foot wide alley, located in Block 10, Polytechnic Heights Addition, an addition to the City of Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas, as shown in the plat thereof recorded in Volume 63, Page 109 of the Plat Records of Tarrant County, Texas, and containing approximately 1,600 square feet or .0367 acres of land, respectively, and as more specifically described in Exhibits A and B attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference be and the same is vacated and extinguished.

SECTION 2.

That the easement to the land in the above-described vacated alley right-of-way is hereby released and shall revert to the adjacent owner as provided by law.

SECTION 3.

All existing utility easements shall be retained by the City until such time all utilities located in that easement are relocated at the owner's expense.
