



Narrative Description


The Northwest Patrol Division design seamlessly blends the past and present, honoring the area's roots while embracing the city's ongoing growth, diversity, and community development. By juxtaposing old and new materials, the sculpture embodies values of history and inclusion, supporting small businesses and fostering family growth – integral elements of this community.

As a welcoming symbol for the public, the sculpture represents the Northwest Patrol Division's commitment to building strong relationships within the community. It is intended to serve as a statement of connection and unity, emphasizing the importance of trust and mutual respect between the Police Department and the citizens they serve. The design's symbolism provides clarity and recognition, tying the abstract concepts of the piece into something familiar and meaningful. The artwork's location is sited near the front of the future Northwest Patrol Division, where it will be highly visible at all times of day, viewable by vehicular traffic as well as department personnel and visitors.


