SUBJECT

(CD 3, CD 5, CD 6, and CD 9) Authorize Execution of a Contract with Omega Contracting Inc., in the Amount of \$1,130,395.00 for 2021 Concrete Restoration Contract 3 at Various Locations

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council authorize execution of a contract with Omega Contracting Inc., in the amount of \$1,130,395.00 for the 2021 Concrete Restoration Contract 3 project (City Project No. 102882) at various locations.

DISCUSSION:

In the Fiscal Year 2021 Pay-Go Contract Street Maintenance Program, various types of street maintenance are grouped into specific contract packages. The 2021 Concrete Restoration Contract 3 provides for the repair and reconstruction of failed concrete pavement at thirteen locations listed on the attached street list (City Project No. 102882). Construction for this project is expected to start in early 2021 and be completed by summer 2021. Upon completion of the project, there will be no anticipated impact on the General Fund operating budget.

This project was advertised for bid on October 1, 2020, and October 8, 2020, in the *Fort Worth Star-Telegram*. On October 29, 2020, the following bids were received:
