SUBJECT: AUTO THEFT UPDATE

The purpose of this informal report is to provide updated information about Auto Thefts around the city of Fort Worth along with prevention tips to keep vehicles secure.

Auto Theft Update:

Between May 1, 2024 and 4 and October 1, 2024 there were 2837 reported auto thefts compared to 2725 for the same time in the previous year.

During this time frame, 2011-2022 Kia and Hyundai models have been targeted because they lack an immobilizer. An immobilizer is an anti-theft device that prevents the vehicle's engine from starting unless the correct key fob is used. This issue has been exacerbated by social media platforms like TikTok, popularizing the "Kia Boyz" trend. Kia and Hyundai have developed theft deterrent software to address this issue.

**SUBJECT: AUTO THEFT UPDATE****Proactive Measures to Combat Auto Theft**

West Division teamed up with Moritz Kia of Fort Worth on May 18, 2024, where the dealership suspended all other maintenance services for the day to address the immobilizer issue, which was a software upgrade. The dealership was able to do the software upgrade on 64 vehicles and handed out several club wheel locks. In order to get the word out, they used several methods to communicate the event:

- * PRO Team social media posts and media advisory
- * Contacted our council districts so they could include in their newsletter(s)
- * Kia communicated the event to every Kia owner within certain zip codes

In addition to the above event, Patrol Divisions have used some of the below tactics:

- Deploying bait vehicles in hotspot areas
- Strategically placing marked and unmanned vehicles as deterrents
- Sharing Crime Bulletins with patrol officers to identify suspects and suspect vehicles
- Identifying surveillance and Flock Camera blind spots for enhancement

Collaborative Efforts

We maintain a strong collaboration with the Tarrant County Auto Theft Task Force, as well as neighboring law enforcement agencies, to effectively target auto theft suspects. By strategically adjusting our operational hours based on evolving crime patterns, we enhance our ability to combat this issue. Additionally, we stay informed about emerging trends and tactics related to vehicle theft throughout the North Texas region, allowing us to proactively address challenges as they arise.

Auto Theft Prevention

We suggest the following tips to help prevent auto thefts:

- When away from home park in a well-lit area or an area with surveillance cameras
- At home, park in garages, driveways, or secured areas
- Lock your car
- Secure your keys

- Kia/Hyundai owners (2011-2022 models): contact local dealerships for software updates

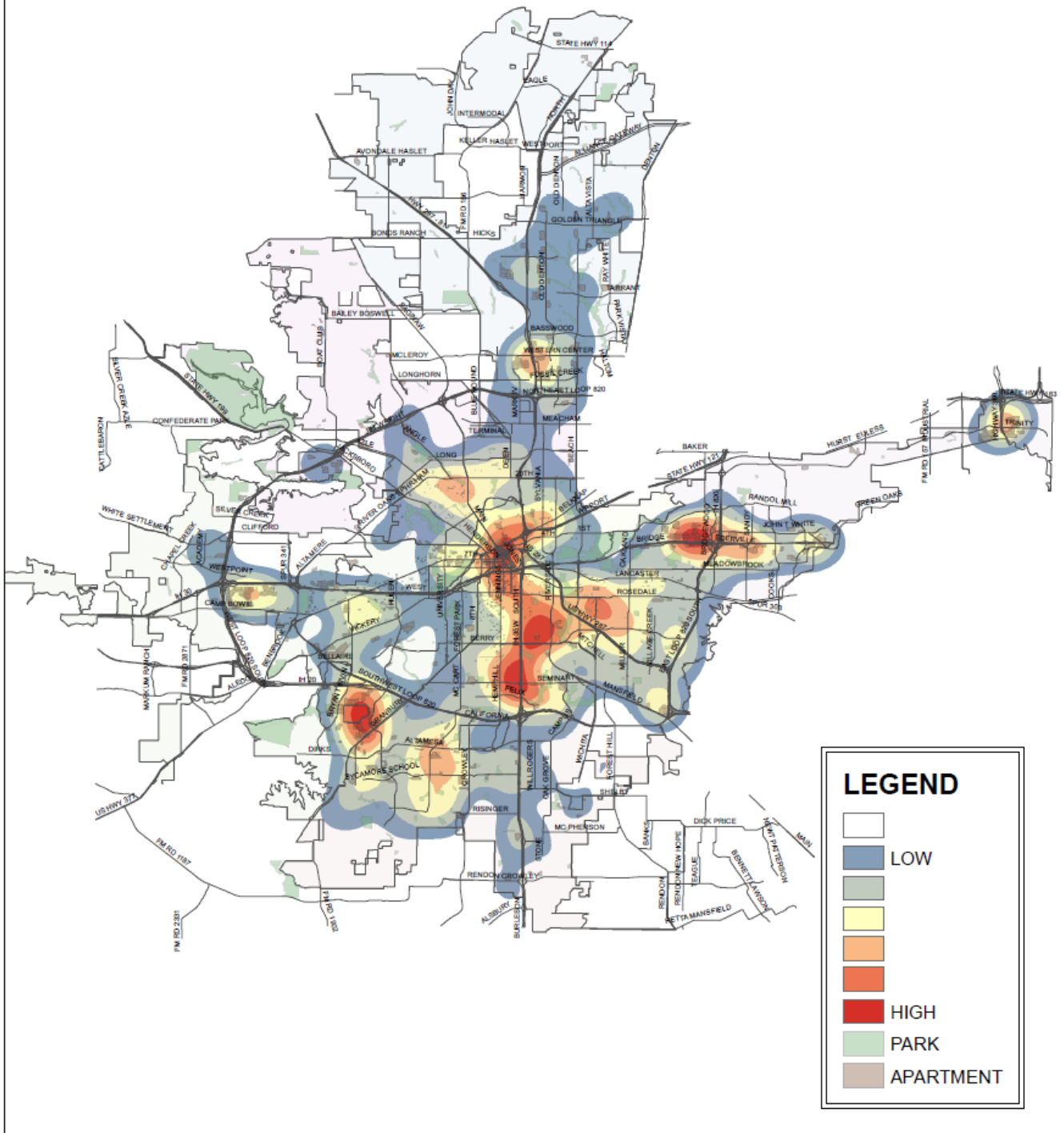
