**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TXDOT) IN THE AMOUNT UP TO \$11,006,805.00 FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE HERITAGE PARK CANOPY WALK FROM NORTHWEST CORNER OF BELKNAP AND HOUSTON DOWN TO TRINITY RIVER**

**WHEREAS**, the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) Program Off System, administered by the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), provides funding for surface transportation projects and other related efforts that contribute air quality improvements and provide congestion relief; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fort Worth (City) applied for, and was awarded Federal funding in the amount up to \$8,000,000.00 for the construction of the Heritage Park Canopy Walk trail from Northwest corner of Belknap and Houston down to the Trinity River Trail system (the “Project”) through the CMAQ Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Transportation Commission passed Minute Order Number 116752 authorizing the State to undertake and complete a highway improvement or other transportation project generally described as bicycle and pedestrian improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fort Worth desires to enter into an Advance Funding Agreement (CSJ: 0902-90-405) with TxDOT for the responsibilities associated with the construction of the Project in the amount up to \$11,006,805.00;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, THAT:**

The City Council authorizes the City Manager, or their designee, to execute an Advance Funding Agreement with TxDOT for the construction of Heritage Park – Shared Use Path / Canopy Walk with Federal Participation in the amount up to \$8,000,000.00, indirect State Participation in the amount up to \$30,305.00, City Participation in the amount up to \$2,000,000.00, to be provided through the 2022 Bond Program, and design phase services for State and Local expenses in an amount up to \$976,000.00, to fulfill the City’s share of its responsibilities. The City will be responsible for all cost overruns.
