**AUTHORIZE APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE, IF AWARDED, OF THE
GRANT PROJECT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 HOMELAND SECURITY URBAN AREA
SECURITY AND STATE HOMELAND SECURITY INITIATIVE GRANT FROM THE
STATE OF TEXAS,
OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE**

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor funds Homeland Security grant projects throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, April 16, 2026, is the deadline to submit application for Fiscal Year 2026 for the Homeland Security Grant Program ; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Fort Worth finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Fort Worth to utilize grant funds from the Office of the Governor for the Fort Worth Fire Department in accordance with the permitted uses of the funds under the respective grant; and

WHEREAS, further council action will be required for the appropriation of funds for these grants at a later date.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, THAT:

1. The City Council authorizes applications for, and acceptance, if awarded, of the following Fiscal Year 2026 grant from the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Homeland Security Grant Program;
2. The City Council designates the City Manager, through the Assistant City Manager for Fire, William Johnson, to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate each listed grant on behalf of the City;
3. The City Council designates the Financial Officer, Catherine Perry, to submit financial reports for reimbursement for each listed grant on behalf of the City;
4. If matching funds are required, the City assures that all matching funds will be provided; and
5. In the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor grant funds, the City assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.
