AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CITY'S SHARE OF THE COSTS FOR PARTICIPATING IN A COMMUNITY FACILITIES AGREEMENT WITH SRPF D/HYDE RANCH PHASE I, L.P. FOR THE HYDE RANCH PROJECT TO CONSTRUCT A TWENTY-FOUR INCH SANITARY SEWER FORCE MAIN; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE IS CUMULATIVE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Worth participates in the cost of public improvements constructed by developers in the City of Fort Worth and its extraterritorial jurisdiction pursuant to Community Facilities Agreements; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 271, Subchapter C of the Texas Local Government Code provides that when the City enters into a contract with a developer that is exempt from the competitive sealed bidding procedures in order to participate in the cost of public improvements, the City must establish by ordinance the City's share of the costs under the contract; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has adopted a unit price ordinance to establish the City's share of the costs when the City participates in a Community Facilities Agreement, with the most recently adopted ordinance being Ordinance Number 23657-05-2019 ("Unit Price Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to participate in a Community Facilities Agreement with SRPF D/Hyde Ranch Phase I, L.P. ("Developer") for the Hyde Ranch project in order for the City to pay one hundred percent of the cost of a constructing a twenty-four inch sanitary sewer force main ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project was privately bid and the Community Facilities Agreement will be executed in accordance with Chapter 212, Subchapter C of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the force main will be constructed from a special material, which is not contained within the Unit Price Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Worth Water Department have been unable to identify a recent project that was publicly bid that contains the material pursuant to the alternative methods authorized by the Unit Price Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Worth Water Department has reviewed the unit prices submitted by the Developer's contractor and find that the prices are fair and reasonable and less than the opinion of probable construction cost provided by the City's engineer; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary to adopt this ordinance to establish the City's share of the participation in the Community Facilities Agreement in order to comply with Section 212.072 of the Texas Local Government Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. CITY PARTICIPATION

The City shall pay one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of the construction of the 24-inch sanitary force main set forth in the Community Facilities Agreement with Developer based upon the unit prices set forth in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances and of the Code of the City of Fort Worth, Texas, (2015), as amended, except where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances and such Code, in which event conflicting provisions of such ordinances and such Code are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance are severable, and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION 4.

This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption, and it is so ordained.
