#### **SUBJECT**

(CD 3) Ratify the Acceptance of a Donation of \$9,000.00 from the Tanglewood Elementary School for Overton Park, Adopt Appropriation Ordinance, and Amend the Fiscal Years 2025-2029 Capital Improvement Program

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Ratify the acceptance of a donation of \$9,000.00 from the Tanglewood Elementary School for Overton Park;
- 2. Adopt the attached appropriation ordinance increasing estimated receipts and appropriations in the Special Donations Capital Projects Fund in the amount of \$9,000.00 from a donation received from the Tanglewood Elementary School for Overton Park for the purpose of contributing funding to the FY21 Playgrounds (South) project (City Project No. 101649); and
- 3. Amend the Fiscal Years 2025 2029 Capital Improvement Program.

### **DISCUSSION:**

The purpose of this Mayor & Council Communication (M&C) is to ratify acceptance of a donation of \$9,000.00 from the Tanglewood Elementary School for Overton Park.

During the construction of a new playground in Overton Park, the Tanglewood Elementary School raised funding, via a Go Fund Me account, in honor of a school custodian who had recently passed away. The purpose of the donation was for the purchase and installation of five picnic tables. These five new picnic tables have been added to the asset inventory and will be maintained by the Park & Recreation Department.

The donation was not included in the Fiscal Years (FY) 2025 - 2029 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) since it was not anticipated. The action in this M&C will amend the FY2025 - 2029 Capital Improvement Program as approved in connection with Ordinance 27107-09-2024.

A Form 1295 is not required because: This M&C does not request approval of a contract with a business entity.

### **FISCAL INFORMATION / CERTIFICATION:**

The Director of Finance certifies that funds are currently available in the FY21 Playgrounds (South) project within the Special Donations Cap Projects Fund and upon approval of the above recommendations and adoption of the attached appropriation ordinance, funds will be available in the Special Donations Cap Projects Fund for the FY21 Playgrounds (South) project.
