APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE FORT WORTH INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT REGARDING JOINT USE OF CERTAIN OUTDOOR SCHOOL FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Worth ("City") and the Fort Worth Independent School District ("FWISD") are political subdivisions of the State of Texas and are authorized to enter into interlocal agreements pursuant to Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code;

WHEREAS, the City and FWISD desire to collaborate on the joint use of certain outdoor school facilities ("Joint Use Areas") located on FWISD campuses to increase the percentage of Fort Worth residents within a 10-minute walk of a park or open space, as recommended by the Trust for Public Land and the City's Good Natured Greenspace Initiative and to promote efficient use of public resources;

WHEREAS, City and FWISD desire to enter into an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement outlining the responsibilities of the City and FWISD concerning public access, maintenance, security, and capital improvements of designated Joint Use Areas;

WHEREAS, the joint use of these outdoor facilities during non-school hours will promote community health and wellness and provide safe recreational spaces for the residents of Fort Worth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, THAT:

- 1. The City Manager or their designee is hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with FWISD for joint use of certain FWISD outdoor facilities during non-school hours and to take all actions necessary to carry out the terms of the Agreement.
- 2. The City of Fort Worth certifies that the Agreement complies with the requirements of Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code.
