**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$660,162.00, WITH FEDERAL PARTICIPATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$385,831.00, STATE PARTICIPATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$23,361.00 AND LOCAL PARTICIPATION IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$250,970.00, FOR ENGINEERING, ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES AND CONSTRUCTION OF SOUTH HULEN STREET AT OAKMONT BOULEVARD HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, federal law establishes federally funded programs for transportation improvements to implement its public purposes, and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Transportation Code, Section 201.103 establishes that the State shall design, construct and operate a system of highways in cooperation with local governments, and Section 222.052 authorizes the Texas Transportation Commission to accept contributions from political subdivisions for development and construction of public roads and the state highway system within the political subdivision, and

**WHEREAS**, federal and state laws require local governments to meet certain contract standards relating to the management and administration of State and federal funds, and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Transportation Commission has codified 43 TAC, Rules 15.50-15.56 that describe federal, state, and local responsibilities for cost participation in highway improvement and other transportation projects, and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Transportation Commission passed Minute Order Numbers 116292 and 116073 authorizing the State to undertake and complete a highway improvement or other transportation project generally described as rehabilitate traffic signal, improve traffic signals and add left turn lane; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fort Worth identified the need to improve traffic signals and construct an additional northbound left turn lane at the South Hulen Street at Oakmont Boulevard intersection; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fort Worth and Texas Department of Transportation have negotiated terms of an Advance Funding Agreement in the amount of \$660,162.00, with federal participation in the amount of \$385,831.00, state participation in the amount of \$23,361.00 and local participation in the approximate amount of \$250,970.00, for engineering, environmental services and construction of South Hulen Street at Oakmont Boulevard highway safety project improvements.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE**

**CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, THAT:**

The City Manager or their designee is hereby authorized to execute an Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation (CSJ: 0902-90-212) in the amount of \$660,162.00, with federal participation in the amount of \$385,831.00, state participation in the amount of \$23,361.00 and local participation in the approximate amount of \$250,970.00, for engineering, environmental services and construction of South Hulen Street at Oakmont Boulevard highway safety project improvements. All cost overruns will be the responsibility of the City of Fort Worth.
