

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND EXTINGUISHING A 16 FOOT WIDE ALLEY, LOCATED IN BLOCK 65, CHAMBERLAIN ARLINGTON HEIGHTS SECOND FILING, AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS ACCORDING TO THE PLAT RECORDED IN VOLUME 63, PAGE 40 OF THE DEED RECORDS OF TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 7,967 SQUARE FEET OF LAND; PROVIDING FOR REVERSION OF FEE IN SAID LAND; PROVIDING THAT THE CITY SHALL RETAIN ALL EXISTING UTILITIES EASEMENTS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That a sixteen foot wide alley, located in Block 65, Chamberlin Arlington Heights Second Filing, an addition to the City of Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas, as shown in the plat thereof recorded in Volume 63, Page 40 of the Plat Records of Tarrant County, Texas, and containing approximately 2,390 square feet or 0.0549 acres of land and 5,577 square feet or 0.1280 acres of land, respectively, and as more specifically described in Exhibits A and B attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference be and the same is vacated and extinguished.

SECTION 2.

That the easement to the land in the above-described vacated alley right-of-way is hereby released and shall revert to the adjacent owner as provided by law.

SECTION 3.

All existing utility easements shall be retained by the City until such time all utilities located in that easement are relocated at the owner's expense.

SECTION 4.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5.

That this ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
