SUBJECT

(CD 3) Authorize the Acquisition of Approximately 0.084 Acres in a Permanent Sanitary Sewer Easement, and Approximately 0.101 Acres for a Temporary Construction Easement from Property Owned by Justin and Maria Keller Located at 4933 Corriente Lane, Benbrook, Tarrant County, Texas, 76126 in the Francis M. Wales Survey, Abstract No. 1637, in the Amount of \$104,627.90 and Pay Estimated Closing Costs in an Amount Up to \$5,000.00 for a Total Cost of \$109,627.90 for the Mary's Creek Force Main Project

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Authorize the acquisition of approximately 0.084 acres in a permanent sanitary sewer easement, and approximately 0.101 acres for a temporary construction easement from property owned by Justin and Maria Keller located at 4933 Corriente Lane, Benbrook, Tarrant County, Texas, 76126 in the Francis M. Wales Survey, Abstract No. 1637, for the Mary's Creek Lift Station Site & Force Main Alignment Project (City Project No. 103648);
2. Find that the total purchase price of \$104,627.90 is just compensation and pay estimated closing costs in an amount up to \$5,000.00 for a total cost of \$109,627.90; and
3. Authorize the City Manager or his designee to accept the conveyance and record the appropriate instruments.

DISCUSSION:

The purpose of this Mayor and Council Communication is to recommend the approval of the acquisition of certain easement interests for the Mary's Creek Lift Station Site & Force Main Alignment Project (City Project No. 103648). The project consists of constructing a force main and will extend approximately six miles from 315 Winscott Road to the Mary's Creek Water Reclamation Facility at 11091 Chapin Road. The force main will be installed by open cut with the exception of major road crossings which will require tunneling and boring.

An independent appraisal established the property's fair market value and the property owner has agreed to the negotiated amount of \$104,627.90 as total compensation for the needed easement interests (as shown below). The City of Fort Worth will pay estimated closing costs in an amount up to \$5,000.00.

Upon City Council approval, staff will proceed with acquiring the needed permanent sanitary sewer easement (PSSE), and temporary construction easement interests (TCE).
