WHEREAS, Loraine Coleman was designated by City Council in 2020 to act in this capacity, has been continually serving in this capacity since her designation, and is a property tax professional who is actively involved in the assessment of ad valorem taxes and is registered with the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation.
