It is recommended that the City Council:

- Authorize execution of an engineering agreement with Gresham Smith in the amount of \$318,160.00, for Water and Sanitary Sewer Replacement, Contract 2020, WSM-M project; and
- 2. Adopt the attached appropriation ordinance increasing estimated receipts and appropriations in the Water and Sewer Capital Projects Fund in the amount of \$479,599.00, transferred from available funds within the Water and Sewer Fund, for the purpose of funding the Water and Sanitary Sewer Replacement, Contract 2020, WSM-M project (City Project No. 103413).

DISCUSSION:

This Mayor and Council Communication (M&C) is to authorize the execution of an engineering agreement with Gresham Smith for the preparation of plans and specifications for sanitary sewer and water main replacements on the following streets and alleys:
