NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, THAT:

- That pursuant to Chapter VI, Section 3, of the City Charter, Leon Carter and the Carter Arnett Law Firm are retained to provide legal representation to the City in the lawsuit entitled, Joel F. Fitzgerald, Sr. v. City of Fort Worth, Texas (Cause No. DC -19-08184).
- 2. That the City be authorized to compensate Leon Carter and the Carter Arnett Law Firm, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00.
