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## TO CONTINUE REVIEW OF THE VIABILITY OF A PUBLICLY FUNDED SOCCER FACILITY

**WHEREAS**, in 2019, the FW Sports Authority commissioned a study to determine the opportunities for Fort Worth to participate in the youth sports tourism market;

**WHEREAS**, the study recommended that a soccer facility would provide growth in the City's youth sports tourism market,

**WHEREAS**, the FW Sports Authority commissioned a second study to determine the best sites for a soccer facility to participate in the youth sports tourism market;

**WHEREAS**, City Council subsequently asked City staff to investigate the viability of including a professional league soccer team and larger stadium than was previously recommended as part of the site plans for a soccer facility and expand the intended market from only youth sports tourism; and

**WHEREAS**, the FW Sports Authority contracted with CSL International to provide a viability study for including a larger soccer stadium as a part of the soccer facility that could host a professional league soccer team.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, THAT:

- 1. The City Council hereby expresses its support for City staff to continue investigating the viability and funding capacity of the City to build a publicly funded soccer facility which includes a new stadium large enough to host a professional league soccer team.
- 2. City staff is directed to continue working with the FW Sports Authority and its consultant, CSL International, to take all necessary actions to finalize the cost of constructing such a publicly funded soccer facility.
