TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT TO BE PAID TO THE LAW FIRM OF CARTER ARNETT, PLLC AS OUTSIDE LEGAL COUNSEL FOR LEGAL SERVICES RELATED TO JOEL F. FITZGERALD, SR. V. CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS (CAUSE NO. DC-19-08184)

WHEREAS, Joel Fitzgerald, Sr. (hereinafter "Fitzgerald") was hired as the Chief of Police for the City of Fort Worth in 2015; and

WHEREAS, Fitzgerald's employment with the City was terminated on May 20, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Fitzgerald sued the City on June 6, 2019, alleging violations of the Texas Whistleblower Act, the Texas Open Meetings Act, the Public Information Act, and the Texas Constitution; and

WHEREAS, because of the complex nature of the litigation and the importance to the City, is it necessary to hire outside legal counsel with extensive expertise in employment law; and

WHEREAS, the City, on January 3. 2022 hired the law firm of Carter Arnett, PLLC, as outside counsel to provide legal representation regarding the lawsuit filed by Fitzgerald, such hiring being ratified by the City Council on February 8, 2022; and

WHEREAS, to date, the cost of legal services by Carter Arnett, PLLC, has been approximately \$190,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the subject litigation is still pending and it is estimated that an additional amount of approximately \$250,000.00 beyond the current authorized \$250,000.00 will be needed for the legal services necessary for legal services through the summer 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS:

That the compensation authorized to be paid to the Law Firm of Carter Arnett, PLLC, as outside counsel, to provide legal representation regarding the lawsuit filed by Fitzgerald, is hereby increased from \$250,000.00 to an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00.
